Preschool

Elementary

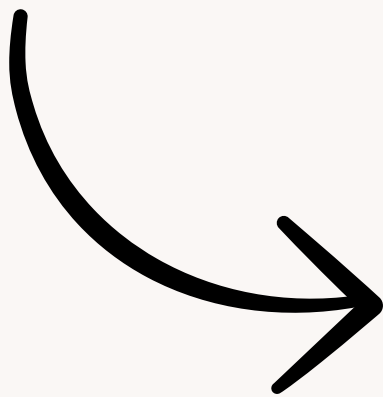
Our students also put this call to serve to action the other night prepping for our Egg Hunt!
